Contributor: Shelby Grossman Exercise: Content moderation and the pandemic

Note for instructors: This exercise works well for in-class small-group discussion.

Platforms currently combine automated content moderation methods with human review. When the pandemic began, platforms acknowledged that they would have to rely more on automated review, as moderators can't look at content in their homes, for privacy reasons, and for safety reasons offices opened at only limited capacity. Platforms acknowledged this increased reliance on automation would lead to more errors.

Imagine you worked at YouTube at the start of the pandemic. You know you will have reduced staffing for the next few months. What type of content would you prioritize for your limited human reviewers? Will you make this decision based on severity of abuse type, or by precision of automated methods across abuse types (eg maybe automation has higher precision for detecting violent content v. misinformation), or by some other metric? What will be the downsides of your decision?

Exercise title: Harassment and hate speech nexus

For the last 15 minutes of a class on harassment and hate speech, ask students to do a free-write on the relationship between harassment and hate speech (5 minutes). Then have them meet with a classmate and compare their responses (5 minutes). Then come back logether as a class and ask some students to share themes from their discussion.

Exercise title: Brainstorming harassment or hate speech policies

Put students into small groups, and have them pick one online platform. (Example platforms: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, Snapchat, or YouTube.) The students should imagine they are platform users, and they should brainstorm what kind of guidelines they would want the platform to have on either harassment or hate speech. This exercise would work well at the start of class.






